The morning keynote address will be presented by Craig Hillier, author of Playing Beyond the Scoreboard. The afternoon keynote address will be presented by Jessie Vetter, U.S. Olympic Hockey Team Goalie and former WIAA State champion and participant. The subjects for the five break-out presentations available during the three time slots are "The Coach and Participants Role in Sportsmanship" by Mark Maas, a veteran teacher and coach; "School Sportsmanship Expectations" by John Frizzell & Mel Dow of the WIAA Sportsmanship Committee; "Sportsmanship: The Official's Prospective" by Ken Koester, a veteran WIAA licensed official; "Peer Leadership for Better Sportsmanship" by Dan Hoppe, Kim Kargus-Myers and Rachel Ley representing the Wisconsin Association of School Councils; and "Sportsmanship Roundtable Discussions" moderated by Shane Been of the WIAA Sportsmanship Committee.
