WIAA BOYS GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS TEE OFF AT UNIVERSITY RIDGE

**Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association
Boys State Golf Championships
Monday-Tuesday, June 8-9, 2009
University Ridge Golf Course, Madison, Wis.**

THE MEET: The 84th Annual Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association Boys Golf Championships will be held Monday and Tuesday, June 8-9, at the University Ridge Golf Course in Madison, Wis. Competition will begin at 7 a.m. on both days. Practice rounds Sunday begin at 7 a.m. Practice tee time assignments are posted on the WIAA Boys Golf Web site.

THE FORMAT: The competition features 16 teams and 24 individual qualifiers in Division 1, and eight teams and 12 individuals in Divisions 2 and 3. Weather permitting, all competitors will play 36 holes, including 18 holes on each day. The lowest scores from the first day will have the later tee times Tuesday.

THE FIELD: In Division 1, the field consists of the top two teams from each of the eight sectionals. In Divisions 2 and 3, the top two teams from each of the four sectionals qualify. The top three individuals, who are not members of a qualifying team in each sectional, also qualify for the meet.

ON THE AIR: A 60-minute highlight program of the 2009 Boys State Golf Championship Tournament is scheduled to air on FSN Wisconsin July 13 at 9 p.m. Check your local listings for the FSN Wisconsin channel on your cable system.

LAST YEAR: Arrowhead captured the Division 1 State title for the second consecutive year, shooting a four-player, 36-hole score of 599, four strokes better than runner-up Madison Memorial. Mike Battista of Madison West earned medalist honors with a 36-hole score of 140. Xavier won the Division 2 title with a four-player, 36-hole score of 622. Edgewood placed second with 626 strokes. Cody Strang of

Edgewood was the medalist with a score of 147, edging Mike Hesselman of Edgerton in a playoff. Eleva-Strum captured the Division 3 title with a score of 665, six shots better than runner-up Sevastopol. Jake Nelson of Ladysmith fired a 152 to win medalist honors.

CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES: Madison West holds the record for the most team golf titles with 15. Osseo-Fairchild is next in line with eight, followed by Racine Park with seven. Madison West has also produced the most individual champions with nine. Four schools have won three straight championships. Osseo-Fairchild did it in 1994-96; Racine did it in 1923-25; Madison West accomplished the feat in 1934-36; and Middleton did it from 1997-99.

TEAMS COMPETING: The schools qualifying for the State meet in Division 1 are defending champion Arrowhead, Badger, Beaver Dam, Burlington, Eau Claire Memorial, Green Bay Preble, Green Bay Southwest, Holmen, Homestead, Kettle Moraine, Marquette, Middleton, Oshkosh West, Racine Horlick, Sheboygan North and Wausau East. Teams qualifying in Division 2 are Catholic Memorial, Edgewood, McFarland, Mosinee, Northwestern, Notre Dame, University School and defending champion Xavier. Qualifying teams in Division 3 are Arcadia, Assumption, Cambridge, Grantsburg, Hurley, Kenosha St. Joseph, Roncalli and Sevastopol.
