Are you a current or former member of the Armed Services?

The WIAA is offering individuals that have served or are still serving in the Armed Forces the opportunity to license as a WIAA sport official by waiving the basic licensing fee and the sport fee for two years. This offer is extended to those individuals that are licensing as a WIAA sport official for the first time or renewing their license for their second year.

Are you a high school student interested in becoming an official?

Individuals in high school may apply for licensing and officiate contests up to and including the 9th grade level. High school students, classified as Limited/Restricted (L/R), are allowed to officiate subvarsity contests in all sports except hockey as long as they are assigned with a fully licensed, non-high school official. High school student officials are also able to be assigned as lines people for varsity contest in soccer. After two years experience as a L/R official there is opportunity for advancement to L2 upon graduation.
