WIAA Provides Opportunities; Structure . . .

The Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) is a voluntary, unincorporated, and nonprofit organization. The Association membership has a diversified membership of public high schools, nonpublic high schools, public middle schools, and nonpublic middle schools. Its purpose is to organize, develop, direct and provide interscholastic athletics for member schools.

There are 514 senior high schools affiliated with the WIAA. The estimated number of student-athletes in athletics is 80,000-85,000 annually.

Governance of the WIAA is performed by the member schools. Rules and policies of the Association are developed, promulgated and implemented by the membership either through membership vote for constitutional issues or through a membership-elected committee structure for sport seasons regulations. Therefore, ownership of the membership's rules and regulations, as well as the responsibility of compliance with them, lies with each member school.

The Development of Rules . . .

As fans watch the games during the tournament, some wonder how the rules of the game and of the WIAA were created.

- ◆ The National Federation of State High School Associations is the authority of the competition rules for sport contests (i.e. uniforms, length of contest, game rules). As a member of the NFHS, the WIAA adheres to those rules as a member in good standing. The WIAA, as well as all state associations in the NFHS, has input with an advisory role in the review and promulgation of the playing rules. The NFHS office is located in Indianapolis, Indiana.
- ◆ For changes to the membership's Constitution, Bylaws and Rules of Eligibility, a vote of the entire membership is required at the Annual Meeting each spring. The Constitution contains information relating to the Association as an organization. The Bylaws encompass information relating to member high schools' responsibility concerning WIAA rules and regulations. The Rules of Eligibility embody information relating to the relationship of the student-athlete to the high school and the WIAA.
- ◆ The Board of Control has the ultimate authority in determining the outcome of sport seasons rule recommendations and regulations. Changes to the sport seasons regulations are advanced through the democratic committee structure. Among the advisory groups that provide input to the Board are the coaches advisory committees for each sport; the sports advisory committee, comprised of school athletic directors from each of the seven districts; the Advisory Council, consisting of school administrators from each elector district; and the executive staff. Other groups with advisory responsibilities include the Medical Advisory Committee, Sportsmanship Committee and the Officials Advisory Committee. The Season Regulations address, among other topics, definition of the sports seasons, participation, contest control and tournament procedures.

Currently, the Association sponsors 24 sports including baseball, basketball, cross country, 8-player, 11-player football, golf, hockey, soccer, swimming & diving, tennis, track & field, volleyball and wrestling for boys; and basketball, cross country, golf, gymnastics, hockey, soccer, softball, swimming & diving, tennis, track & field and volleyball for girls.

2021 State Preview

Four events feature the 2019 champion or champions competing, including three relays. Two of the relays have both the 2019 Division 1 champion and the Division 2 champion qualifying. The 200 and 400 freestyle relays feature Sun Prairie, the 2019 Division 1 champion, and Edgewood, the Division 2 champion. The Crusaders have actually won five straight Division 2 titles in the 200-yard freestyle relay and four straight in the 400-yard freestyle relay. Edgewood enters competition with the fastest qualifying time in the both the freestyle relays at 1:36.61 in the 200 and 3:30.61 in the 400. Middleton and Sun Prairie are the second and third fastest qualifying relays in both events, respectively. The Crusaders also won the 200 medley relay in Division 2 in 2019. They are seeded second in that event this season with a time of 1:46.70. Sun Prairie, which placed third in Division 1 in 2019, has the best time entering the meet at 1:46.55. Senior Hallory Domnick of Ashwaubenon won the Division 2 title in the 500 freestyle in 2019. She is seeded third this year, behind Sophomore Izzy Enz of Edgewood, who has the quickest qualifying time of 4:57.55, and sophomore Peyton Drexler of Edgewood, who placed ninth in Division 1 in 2019 for Verona/Mount Horeb. Domnick is also the top finisher from the State Meet in the 100 butterfly, having placed runner-up in 2019. She possesses the second-best qualifying time in the event this season at 56.54. Neverman is the fastest qualifier in the 100 butterfly with a time of 55.97. Enz also has the fastest qualifying time in the 200 freestyle recorded at sectionals with a time of 1:50.74. She looks to capture gold after earning the Division 2 silver medal in the event in 2019. Drexler stakes claim to the top qualifying time in the 200 individual medley at 2:04.11. She should expect a challenge from both lanes beside her. She's flanked on one side by sophomore Bailey Ratzburg of Milton with the second-fastest qualifying time at 2:04.61, and on the other by junior Brigitta Neverman of Green Bay Southwest/East/Preble/West, who was third in Division 1 in 2019. The 50 freestyle field is led by junior Abby Reid of Edgewood. She enters competition with the swiftest qualifying time of 23.79 after a Division 2 runner-up finish in 2019. Reid also placed second in the 100 freestyle in 2019; however, freshman Sienna Nitke of Ashwaubenon has earned the top seed in the event this season

with her sectional time of 51.50. Junior Mara Freeman of McFarland may also contend for the title in the 100 freestyle after placing sixth in Division 2 in 2019. Freeman is also among the top qualifiers in the 100 backstroke. She enters with a time of 56.07, which ranks third-fastest in the event this season. She was the Division 2 runner-up in the event in 2019. Senior Faith Sill of Beloit Memorial owns the top time in the event this season with at 55.67. Junior Anna teDuits of Edgewood should also be considered a serious title contender in the event with the second-fastest qualifying time of 55.96 after placing third in Division 2 in 2019. Freshman Allison Greenway of Appleton North recorded the best sectional time in the 100 breaststroke at 1:04.85, which is just a shade better than senior Sydney Hoff of Stevens Point, who is seeded second with a time of 1:04.88. Senior Julie Rebek of Fond du Lac/Oakfield posted the top qualifying score in the diving competition with a 470.75. She'll need to contend with, among others, senior Bailey Schroeder of Neenah for the title. Schroeder has the second-best qualifying score of 454.85 from sectionals, and she has quality experience at State as well, finishing third in Division 1 in 2019.

- Dual confirmation of a failed dive required during the WIAA tournament series (sectional and state).
- In championship meets, diving referee may consult with a designated member of judging panel concerning a possible failed dive.
- Announcer shall announce (and judges should also display) the award given the dive.
- The Meet Referee has the authority to replace a diving judge with an alternate judge at the sectional meet.

JUDGES' PENALTIES

DEDUCT 1/2 TO 2 POINTS:

- Not stopping the oscillation of the board just before or after the starting position is assumed.
- Excessive oscillation (more than four times)
- A foot or the feet leaving board prior to a back/inward takeoff
- Spreading knees in the tuck position
- Not holding straight position on flying somersaults until body is horizontal to surface of water
- Entering to the side of board
- Twisting manifestly from board

DEFICIENT DIVE (MAXIMUM AWARD 4.5 POINTS):

- Partially alters position of dive during flight

- Enters water with one or both hands above the shoulders on a dive requiring a feet-first entry
- Enters water with one or both hands below the shoulders on a dive requiring a head-first entry

REFEREE'S PENALTIES

UNSATISFACTORY DIVE (MAXIMUM AWARD 2 POINTS):

- Dive clearly done in position other than described on scoresheet
- Hits the diving board
- Diver does not attempt to come out from tucked position
- Diver does not attempt to come out of the twist
- Does not hold the straight position until horizontal to the water on any flying one somersault dive
- Does not hold the straight position until perpendicular to the water on any flying 1-1/2 somersault dive

DEDUCTS 2 POINTS FROM EACH JUDGES AWARD FOR:

- Violation of the forward approach
- Balk

Note: If a diver attempts to change a voluntary dive so that the true DD for the five voluntary dives exceeds 9.0, the change can not be made.

DIVE IS FAILED IF DIVER:

- Executes a dive other than that given on the diving scoresheet.
- Does not assume a starting position.
- Diver falls into the water.
- Diver is assisted by another person.
- Does not execute the pike before the twist when dives Nos. 5111(B), and 5411 (B) are to be done in the pike position.
- Feet touch water first on head-first entry.

- Head/hands touch water first on feet- first entry.
- Twists shoulders 90° more or less than indicated on the diving scoresheet when the diver's feet/hands contact the water.
- Twists the shoulders past 90 degrees before the feet leave the board.
- Repeats a dive.
- Steps off board after assuming the starting position.
- Uses standing forward position on a forward dive.
- Official description of dive (No. & Pos.) not recorded on scoresheet.
- Commits two balks.
- In dual meets, the voluntary dive is not performed first.
- Championship meet voluntary/optional dives not performed as specified.
- Performs dive not listed on the diving table.
- In the referee's opinion, performs additional bounce(s) on the end of the board after the cluminating hurdle.

DIVER IS DISQUALIFIED IF:

- Diver does not make a sincere attempt to perform the dive.
- When dives listed on the scoresheet are obviously too difficult for the diver.
- Diver unnecessarily delays in the performance of a dive.
- Fails to submit completed sheet at the proper time and place.
- For unsportsmanlike conduct.
- For not completing all rounds of dives.
- Diver enters water without permission of diving referee.
- Diver fails two dives for any reason.

AREAS OF CONSIDERATION

The areas of consideration in awarding points are the starting position, approach, takeoff, flight and positions, and entry into the water.

Sectionals were held at Ashwaubenon, Eau Claire North/Verona Area, Jefferson/Beloit Memorial and Oshkosh North/Stoughton.

There were 40 teams represented in sectional competition.

From sectionals, each swimming event winner advances to the State Meet along with the next 12 fastest individuals and relay teams (not including sectional winners) from all sectionals.

In diving, each sectional champion goes on to the State Meet along with the next 12 best individuals (not including sectional winners) from all sectionals.
