

WIAA Provides Opportunities; Structure . . .

The Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association (WIAA) is a voluntary, unincorporated, and nonprofit organization. The Association membership has a diversified membership of public high schools, nonpublic high schools, public middle schools, and nonpublic middle schools. Its purpose is to organize, develop, direct and provide interscholastic athletics for member schools.

There are 515 senior high schools affiliated with the WIAA. The estimated number of student-athletes in athletics is 80,000-85,000 annually.

Governance of the WIAA is performed by the member schools. Rules and policies of the Association are developed, promulgated and implemented by the membership either through membership vote for constitutional issues or through a membership-elected committee structure for sport seasons regulations. Therefore, ownership of the membership's rules and regulations, as well as the responsibility of compliance with them, lies with each member school.

The Development of Rules . . .

As fans watch the games during the tournament, some wonder how the rules of the game and of the WIAA were created.

- ◆ The National Federation of State High School Associations is the authority of the competition rules for sport contests (i.e. uniforms, length of contest, game rules). As a member of the NFHS, the WIAA adheres to those rules as a member in good standing. The WIAA, as well as all state associations in the NFHS, has input with an advisory role in the review and promulgation of the playing rules. The NFHS office is located in Indianapolis, Indiana.
- ◆ For changes to the membership's Constitution, Bylaws and Rules of Eligibility, a vote of the entire membership is required at the Annual Meeting each spring. The Constitution contains information relating to the Association as an organization. The Bylaws encompass information relating to member high schools' responsibility concerning WIAA rules and regulations. The Rules of Eligibility embody information relating to the relationship of the student-athlete to the high school and the WIAA.
- ◆ The Board of Control has the ultimate authority in determining the outcome of sport seasons rule recommendations and regulations. Changes to the sport seasons regulations are advanced through the democratic committee structure. Among the advisory groups that provide input to the Board are the coaches advisory committees for each sport; the sports advisory committee, comprised of school athletic directors from each of the seven districts; the Advisory Council, consisting of school administrators from each elector district; and the executive staff. Other groups with advisory responsibilities include the Medical Advisory Committee, Sportsmanship Committee and the Officials Advisory Committee. The Season Regulations address, among other topics, definition of the sports seasons, participation, contest control and tournament procedures.



Currently, the Association sponsors 24 sports including baseball, basketball, cross country, 8-player, 11-player football, golf, hockey, soccer, swimming & diving, tennis, track & field, volleyball and wrestling for boys; and basketball, cross country, golf, gymnastics, hockey, soccer, softball, swimming & diving, tennis, track & field and volleyball for girls.

2021 State Preview

INDIVIDUAL NOTES-DIVISION 1: Four events feature their 2020 champions attempting to retain their titles, including one individual event and three relays. Senior Ben Wiegand of Sun Prairie is the returning champion in the 50-yard freestyle. He is in position to retain the title based on his qualifying time of 20.33, which leads the field. Wiegand also finished sixth in the event in 2019. He should expect a formidable challenge for the title from junior William Hayon of Sheboygan North, who won the event in 2019 and placed third a year ago, and senior Emilio Perez of Greenfield/Greendale/Pius XI Catholic, who was fifth in 2019 and has the second-fastest qualifying time this season at 20.65. Senior Travis Craig of Franklin is a four-time qualifier in the 50 freestyle, finishing fifth last season, 13th in 2019 and 20th in 2018. Wiegand also has the swiftest qualifying time in the 100 freestyle at 45.64. Craig is the top returning swimmer with a fourth-place finish last year. He also was fourth in 2019 and 10th in 2018. Senior Cory Michalek of Waukesha North/Kettle Moraine/Pewaukee could also be in contention for the title in the 100 freestyle with the second-fastest seed time of 46.05 after placing sixth in 2020 and 16th in 2019. Sophomore Nick Chirafisi of Middleton has the fastest sectional time in the 200 freestyle at 1:42.73 after placing sixth last year. Senior Leo Gandaria of Greenfield/Greendale/Pius XI Catholic is the top returning finisher in the event from a year ago with a third-place finish. Seven of last year's top-10 finishers return in the 500 freestyle. Senior Jackson Lustig of Greenfield/Greendale/Pius XI Catholic could be considered the favorite to win the event this season with the fastest qualifying time of 4:38.02, which is two seconds faster than the time of the next-best competitor. He is also the top returning finisher from last season after placing third to go with sixth-place result in 2019. Among the other experienced challengers for the title are senior Kevin Fitzgerald of West Bend West/East, who was fourth last year and eighth in 2019; Chirafisi, who was fifth last season; senior Alex Foti of Waukesha West/Mukwonago, who was sixth a year ago and 17th in 2019; senior James Werwie of Sun Prairie, who was seventh the past two seasons; and senior Sam Lanham of Waukesha South/Catholic Memorial, who was eighth in 2020, ninth in 2019 and 15th in 2018. Sophomore Lance Johnson leads a trio of Arrowhead swimmers in the fast heat of the 200 individual medley. He enters the meet with the event's top qualifying time of 1:52.63 after placing 11th last season. Werwie, with his sixth-place finish last year, is the top returning competitor in the event with the seventh-fastest seed time of 1:57.03. Perez is the top returning swimmer and the fastest qualifier in the 100 butterfly. He placed runner-up last year and turned in a time of 48.60 at sectionals. Junior Oscar Best of Verona/Mount Horeb and William Hayon should also contend for the title. Hayon has the second-fastest qualifying time at 48.77 after placing fifth in 2019, and Best placed third in the event last year and 12th in 2019. The 100 backstroke should be hotly contested. Senior Adam Braunschweig of Arrowhead leads a tight field of qualifiers with a time of 50.81 after placing third last year, seventh in 2019 and 14th in 2018. Senior Adam Fisher of Muskego is the second-fastest qualifier at 51.22 with a wealth of experience in the event, placing fourth in 2020, 11th in 2019 and 15th in 2018. Junior Brady Miller of Brookfield Central/East is the fastest qualifier in the 100 breaststroke with a seed time of 56.23. He is also the top finisher returning from a year ago after placing fourth. Lance Johnson will challenge Miller for the title with a qualifying time .03 behind the frontrunner after he placed eighth in 2020. Junior Jan Lanser of West Bend West/East is the top returning competitor in the dives after placing third last year. He enters competition with the best qualifying score of 529, well ahead of the next-best qualifying score of 472.20 recorded by junior Azaan McCray of Racine Case, who placed fourth last year and fifth in 2019. The Greenfield/Greendale/Pius XI Catholic 200 medley relay returns to defend its title with a time of 1:33.21, but Arrowhead has the top seed time this year at 1:33.12. The Sun Prairie 200 freestyle relay is the

defending champion with the fastest qualifying time of 1:24.28 in pursuit of a repeat title this season. The Waukesha South/Catholic Memorial 400 freestyle relay returns after winning the championship in the event last year, but it will need to shave time off its qualifying time of 3:18.43 to catch the top qualifier in the event, Sun Prairie, which enters with a time of 3:09.13.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES-DIVISION 2: Two of last year's individual events feature the return of its champion, and two relays return in an attempt to win back-to-back titles. Senior Ben Stigten of Edgewood is looking to become just the third diver to win four State championships and just the seventh competitor to win four times in any event. He enters competition with the second-best qualifying score of 437.15. Freshman Noah Turner of Cedarburg compiled a sectional tally of 470.80 to lead all divers. The other individual pursuing a repeat title is sophomore Isaac Fleig of Cedarburg in the 500-yard freestyle. He comes into the championships with the second-fastest qualifying time of 4:46.15. Junior Jackson Hodek of Ashwaubenon has the top time of 4:44.95 after placing sixth last season and 13th in 2019. Fleig is also one of the favorites in the 200 individual medley. He is the event's quickest qualifier with a time of 1:57.28 coming off a runner-up performance at last year's championships. Junior Kyle Griswood of Shorewood should contend with Fleig for the title after placing sixth last year and possessing a seed time less than a second behind Fleig's at 1:57.98. Sophomore Matt Dederer of Cedarburg is the fastest qualifier and the top returning finisher in both the 50 and 100 freestyles. He clocked in at 21.34 at sectionals in the 50 freestyle after placing third a year ago, and he registered a time of 46.83 in the 100 freestyle after a runner-up performance last season. Seniors Peter McMahon of Whitefish Bay and senior Liam Hogan of Lakeland could also contend for the 50 freestyle title. McMahon has the second fastest time at 21.81, and Hogan the third-fastest at 21.91 after placing fourth last year and runner-up in 2019. Hogan may also challenge Dederer in the 100 freestyle with the second-fastest seed time of 47.90 after placing fourth in the event in 2020. Sophomore Aiden Strath of Shorewood was fourth in the 200 freestyle last season, which is the highest finish of any of the returning competitors in the event. He has the second-fastest qualifying time of 1:44.18 this season, behind only the 1:42.06 turned in by Nicolet freshman Jack Sullivan. Junior Cameron Tejeda of Monona Grove may be the leading contender in the 100 butterfly. His fifth-place finish last season and his sectional qualifying time of 50.46 are tops in the event. Junior Colin Senke of Edgewood also has sights on a title in the event with the second-fastest qualifying time of 50.88. Senke should also be among the earliest finishers in the 100 backstroke, an event he was runner-up in last season and fifth in 2019. He owns the top qualifying time at 50.57, less than a second faster than Tejeda, who qualified with the second-fastest time of 51.33 after placing fifth last year and seventh in 2019. Sophomore Sam King of Sauk Prairie/Wisconsin Heights is the swiftest qualifier by over a second in the 100 breaststroke at 58.25 after placing fifth in the event a year ago. He finished just behind senior Jacob Laux of Baraboo, who was fourth and is the next-fastest qualifier behind King this season at 59.49. The Edgewood 200 medley relay is pursuing its third straight championship. It enters the championships with the third-fastest seed time of 1:39.73, which is less than a second slower than the times of Whitefish Bay at 1:38.57 and Cedarburg at 1:39.44. The Edgewood 400 freestyle relay team is also a two-time defending champion. The quartet will challenge to win its third in a row with the second-fastest qualifying time of 3:17.68, behind only Cedarburg with a time of 3:16.90. The Whitewater 200 freestyle relay is the top qualifier with a time of 1:28.51, coming off a third-place finish from a year ago, which is the highest finish of any other returning relay in the event.

Boys Swimming & Diving History

The WIAA goes back to 1925 to determine the beginning of its boys swimming tournament program. The first meet was held at the University of Wisconsin in Madison. The meet was held indoors, according to WIAA records, because "water on the lake was too rough."

Milwaukee West won the first championship with West Allis runner-up.

The meet was held at a variety of sites through the years, but since 1966, it has been held exclusively at UW-Madison.

Madison Memorial has won 16 team championships to lead all other programs. The Spartans also have 16 runner-up finishes. Madison West and Waukesha (before it became North, South, and West) have won 15 State championships. Seven of Waukesha's titles came in succession (1964-70). All but one came during a 17-year period from 1958-1974. Wauwatosa, before it became two schools with East and West, won nine titles. Seven of those came during an eight-year period from 1944-51. Shorewood also has nine titles, including five in a row from 1935-39 and all nine of them coming from 1933-1943. Arrowhead and McFarland have won six team championships, with all six of McFarland's coming consecutively from 2007-12. Kenosha and Whitefish Bay have won five titles.

Boys swimming and diving was conducted in a single class until 1993 when a two-division format was adopted. Verona won the first Division 2 team championship.

Only six athletes have won the same individual event four times, and Ben McDade of Monona is the only swimmer to win four titles in multiple events. He's a four-time champion in both the 200 and 500 freestyles (2015-18). Kyle Bubolz of Waukesha North/Kettle Moraine was the first to do it. He won the Division 1 50-yard freestyle from 2001-04. Ryan Jefferson of Edgewood accomplished the feat in the diving competition, winning the Division 2 titles from 2003-06. Alex DeLakis of Eau Claire Memorial/North was a four-time Division 1 champion in the 100 breaststroke from 2010-13. In 2015, Joe Kaszubowski of Whitefish Bay was the fourth individual to accomplish the feat, capturing his fourth title in the Division 2 diving competition. Paul DeLakis of Eau Claire Memorial/North joined the ranks of the group when he won his fourth straight 100 breaststroke title in Division 1 in 2017.

There have been 42 three-time winners in the same individual event. Of those, only four individuals have won three titles in two different individual events. John Thuerer of Rhinelander won three titles in the 200 and 400 freestyles; both Edward Garst of Wauwatosa and Tom Wanezek of Brookfield East won three titles in the 50 and 100 freestyles; Tom Shane of New Berlin Eisenhower won three 200 individual medleys and 100 butterflies.

Ben McDade of Monona Grove has won the most titles, including relays, with 15. Ryan O'Donnell of McFarland has won 14, while Ben Anderson of Arrowhead, Jay Mortenson of Madison West, Tom Wanezek of Brookfield East and Paul DeLakis of Eau Claire Memorial/North have won 10. Chris Richard of Sturgeon Bay/Southern Door and Truman teDuits of Edgewood have won nine titles.

Madison Memorial has won the most State event titles with 89, Waukesha, before it split into three schools, recorded 77 individual and relay championships. Madison West has had 75 champions. Wauwatosa crowned 61 champs before forming separate programs.

- Dual confirmation of a failed dive required during the WIAA tournament series (sectional and state).
- In championship meets, diving referee may consult with a designated member of judging panel concerning a possible failed dive.
- Announcer shall announce (and judges should also display) the award given the dive.
- The Meet Referee has the authority to replace a diving judge with an alternate judge at the sectional meet.

JUDGES' PENALTIES

DEDUCT 1/2 TO 2 POINTS:

- Not stopping the oscillation of the board just before or after the starting position is assumed.
- Excessive oscillation (more than four times)
- A foot or the feet leaving board prior to a back/inward takeoff
- Spreading knees in the tuck position
- Not holding straight position on flying somersaults until body is horizontal to surface of water
- Entering to the side of board
- Twisting manifestly from board

DEFICIENT DIVE (MAXIMUM AWARD 4.5 POINTS):

- Partially alters position of dive during flight

- Enters water with one or both hands above the shoulders on a dive requiring a feet-first entry
- Enters water with one or both hands below the shoulders on a dive requiring a head-first entry

REFEREE'S PENALTIES

UNSATISFACTORY DIVE (MAXIMUM AWARD 2 POINTS):

- Dive clearly done in position other than described on scoresheet
- Hits the diving board
- Diver does not attempt to come out from tucked position
- Diver does not attempt to come out of the twist
- Does not hold the straight position until horizontal to the water on any flying one somersault dive
- Does not hold the straight position until perpendicular to the water on any flying 1-1/2 somersault dive

DEDUCTS 2 POINTS FROM EACH JUDGES AWARD FOR:

- Violation of the forward approach
- Balk

Note: If a diver attempts to change a voluntary dive so that the true DD for the five voluntary dives exceeds 9.0, the change can not be made.

DIVE IS FAILED IF DIVER:

- Executes a dive other than that given on the diving scoresheet.
- Does not assume a starting position.
- Diver falls into the water.
- Diver is assisted by another person.
- Does not execute the pike before the twist when dives Nos. 5111(B), and 5411 (B) are to be done in the pike position.
- Feet touch water first on head-first entry.

- Head/hands touch water first on feet- first entry.
- Twists shoulders 90° more or less than indicated on the diving scoresheet when the diver's feet/hands contact the water.
- Twists the shoulders past 90 degrees before the feet leave the board.
- Repeats a dive.
- Steps off board after assuming the starting position.
- Uses standing forward position on a forward dive.
- Official description of dive (No. & Pos.) not recorded on scoresheet.
- Commits two balks.
- In dual meets, the voluntary dive is not performed first.
- Championship meet voluntary/optional dives not performed as specified.
- Performs dive not listed on the diving table.
- In the referee's opinion, performs additional bounce(s) on the end of the board after the cluminating hurdle.

DIVER IS DISQUALIFIED IF:

- Diver does not make a sincere attempt to perform the dive.
- When dives listed on the scoresheet are obviously too difficult for the diver.
- Diver unnecessarily delays in the performance of a dive.
- Fails to submit completed sheet at the proper time and place.
- For unsportsmanlike conduct.
- For not completing all rounds of dives.
- Diver enters water without permission of diving referee.
- Diver fails two dives for any reason.

AREAS OF CONSIDERATION

The areas of consideration in awarding points are the starting position, approach, takeoff, flight and positions, and entry into the water.
