Lawrence College of Appleton conducted high school basketball tournaments from 1905 to 1918, inclusive, and these winners were recognized as state champions by the WIAA from 1905 to 1915, inclusive.

The winners were: 1905 – Fond du Lac, 1906 – Appleton, 1907 – Oshkosh, 1908 – Superior, 1909 – Menomonie, 1910 – La Crosse, 1911 – Appleton, 1912 – Madison Central, 1913 – Janesville, 1914 – Appleton and 1915 – Fond du Lac.

Athletic Directors of the Wisconsin Normal Schools (later known as Teachers College and now called State Colleges) started a tournament program in 1916 with the winners recognized as state champions. Lawrence College's tournament also was held during 1916 (winner – Baraboo), 1917 (winner – Wittenberg) and 1918 (winner – Wisconsin Rapids), and thereafter discontinued.

The WIAA took charge of the tournament program beginning in 1920 and was conducted uninterrupted until 2020 when the State Tournament was canceled because of the Coronavirus pandemic.

The Division 1 format of the tournament was altered with the implementation of the fifth division in 2011 with only four teams qualifying for the State Tournament in the division. The format of the game changed in 2016, going from four 8-minute quarters to two 18-minute halves.
