

Shawano - Winner State Basketball Tournament

Shawano became the third school in history to repeat as Wisconsin state high school basketball champion when it defeated Madison West, 66-61.

Fred Opperman, a burly 6-61/2 center, paced the winners attack with 19 points, followed by Capt. Loren Wolf with 16 and Marty Gharrity with 13.

Four of West's starters scored in double figures, Jim Braun and Jim Bakken had 14 apiece while Jim Rasmussen and Don Quam scored 12 each. The other starter, Jim Horney, was just shy of double figures with nine.

The Indians led 16-8 at the quarter, 38-21 at the half. Quick baskets by Opperman and Mike Dodge as the second half opened gave Shawano a 42-31 lead, but West closed in to a 48-43 score at the three-quarters mark.

Shawano shot .440 with 22 baskets in 50 attempts; West had a .329 figure on 25 baskets in 76 attempts.
