Milwaukee Lincoln made an auspicious return to the throne of Wisconsin high school basketball in 1966.

The Comets from the Milwaukee City Conference flashed past Wisconsin Rapids, 75-62, in the championship game of the 51st annual State Tournament at the University of Wisconsin (Madison).

Lincoln thus regained the title it last held in 1962 while continuing a phenomenal record of never having lost in the State Tournament. The Milwaukeeans, this time coached by Jim Smallins, stretched their all-winning ways to 12 games — three wins in each of four title-gaining years — 1959, 1961 and 1962 before 1966.

The triumph by Lincoln was not unexpected. The Comets were generally regarded as favorites before the State Meet got underway. This fact was true despite the presence of three undefeated teams at Madison — Alma, Green Bay West and Madison East. Lincoln, however, had almost a perfect record — 22 wins in 23 games going into the finals, and the Comets wound up their great campaign with a 25-1 mark.

Wisconsin Rapids, on the other hand, was a surprise finalist and in most circles a surprise State Meet qualifier. The Red Raiders were only 12-6 in the regular season (runnerup in the Wisconsin Valley Conference) but they won eight in a row in tournament play before bowing in the championship game to finish with a 20-7 mark for the campaign.

Third-place honors in the customarily exciting tournament played before record-breaking crowds went to Alma, the smallest school in the field, by virtue of a 66-54 triumph over Grafton, the second-smallest school in the tournament. Consolation honors went to Madison East, a 61-53 victor in one of three tournament overtimes with Eau Claire Memorial the victim.

Upsets dotted the opening round of play which began with sentimental favorite Alma's expected but hard-fought 88-80 overtime win over Neenah, another team which came to Madison unheralded but gave a good account of itself. Then followed an expected Lincoln win over Eau Claire Memorial, 76-57, followed by two surprises. Madison East and Green Bay West — each with perfect 23-0 marks — were cut down by inspired Grafton and Wisconsin Rapids by scores of 63-59 and 66-52, respectivley.

Semi-final action saw Lincoln subdue gallant Alma, 82-72, followed by Rapids' 67-58 win over Grafton. Consolation semi-finals resulted in Eau Claire Memorial winning over Neenah, 73-67, in the Rockets' second overtime loss and Madison East beating Green Bay West — in a battle of the state's two No. 1 rated teams, 68-41.

Unblemished records were posted during the regular season by no fewer than seven schools. Alma, Altoona, Green Bay West and Madison East all won 18 games, Eagle River and Stockbridge won 17 games each and New Holstein won 16 games — all without a loss.

Alma stretched its string to 25 before losing in the semi-finals of the State and eventually finishing with a 26-1 record. Altoona went to 21 without a loss, then was beaten in the Sub-Sectionals. Green Bay West and Madison East both went to 23 without a loss and the first round of the State Meet before losing—then West finished with a 23-2 mark and East with 25-1. Eagle River was beaten the second night in the Sub-Regional finals, finishing 18-1, while Stockbridge lost its first game in the tournament trail and wound up with 17-1.

Eight other teams had regular season records which showed only one defeat. Lincoln was one of them and others who had 17 victories during the regular season with only one loss were Manawa, Orfordville, River Falls and Wausaukee. Baraboo, Barron and Platteville all were 16-1 for the year. Lincoln, of course, went all the way after its regular season. Baraboo and Platteville got to the Sectional

finals before finishing with 21-2 marks while Wausaukee, Manawa and River Falls all were beaten in the first round of the Sectionals — Wausaukee finishing at 22-2 and Manawa and River Falls at 21-3. Orfordville and Barron both went to the Sub-Sectionals before losing, thus finishing with 20-2 and 19-2 records, respectively, for the year.

A record total of 388,323 spectators watched 1966 tournament series play. That figure compared to 384,457 the previous year which was the record prior to 1966. It was estimated that between 3-4 million persons watched the approximately 3,500 regular season basketball games of WIAA member schools.
