General Admission tickets are available in limited numbers per school and will be adjusted based on the number purchased by each team. Limit per game is 300 tickets per participating school.

Admissions: Up to 25 players in Uniforms, 2 Support Staff, and 2 Coaches. Team admission is only for

Please bring both uniforms. We will adjust as needed for the Championship Game.

Laundry is available near school if needed.

Locker Rooms: Locker Rooms/Team Rooms will not be available for the 2020 Playoffs unless weather

dictates. Please come dressed and plan to stay on field at half. If inclement weather does arise, we will provide a sheltered halftime area. Due to social distancing expectations we

are unable to provide shelters on the sidelines.

Warm-up Area: We will have a grass warm-up and stretching area if we are delayed at any point during the

day for teams upon arrival.

Concessions: Will be available and please no carry-ins.

Game Film: Games will be recorded for each school and shared at the end of each contest via Hudl. We

will not be able to accommodate individual team filming from our press box. If individual game film is required, we will accommodate behind team benches from outside the press

responsible for issues as they arise.

Seating: Main Grandstand seating will be split in half. Stadium is marked in groups of four

"Tiger Paws". We ask that groups of 2-4 sit together on those paws and socially distance. These will be in Section B, C, D, and E. Student sections when needed, will

be in Sections A and F and will be marked individually 6 ft apart.

Media: Media requests for interviews will take place outside at location to be determined

based on weather and wind. We will communicate that upon arrival to the site.
