## WIAA GIRLS STATE GOLF TOURNAMENT—2022 UNIVERSITY RIDGE GOLF COURSE NOTICE TO PLAYERS

## USGA RULES APPLY EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY THE WIAA HARD CARD (LOCAL RULES AND TERMS OF COMPEITION) AND BY THE FOLLOWING

TEES	All play will be from the red tee-markers.
RED PENALTY AREAS	Defined by red stakes and/or red lines. The lines prevail.
YELLOW PENALTY AREAS	Defined by yellow stakes and/or yellow lines. The lines prevail. Yellow penalty areas are located on hole 2, hole 5, and hole 8.
OUT OF BOUNDS	Defined by the course-side edge of the public road on hole 2 and hole 3.
HOLE 1 DROPPING ZONE FOR BALL IN RED PENALTY BEHIND HOLE 1	As an extra penalty relief option if a ball is in the red penalty area behind hole 1 putting green, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the red penalty area behind hole 1 putting green, the player may drop the original ball or another ball in the nearest dropping zone located behind hole 1 putting green.
HOLE 8 DROPPING ZONE FOR BALL IN YELLOW PENALTY AREA	As an extra penalty relief option if a ball is in the yellow penalty area on hole 8, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the yellow penalty area and the ball last crossed the edge of the yellow penalty area, the player may drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone located near the creek on hole 8. This extra option is not available if the ball entered the penalty area by last crossing the edge of a red penalty area.
HOLE 9 DROPPING ZONE FOR RETAINING WALL, PAVILION AND SCORING TENT BEHIND HOLE 9	The retaining wall (and flower beds contained within the retaining wall), the clubhouse, and the pavilion behind hole 9 putting green, are treated as a single immovable obstruction. The scoring tent is treated as a separate immovable obstruction, not a TIO. As an extra free relief option if a player has interference from either obstruction, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in one of the obstructions, the player may drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone located behind hole 9 putting green.
HOLE 9 DROPPING ZONE FOR FLOWER BED TO LEFT OF HOLE 9 PUTTING GREEN	The flower bed to the left of hole 9 putting green is ground under relief, for which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1. As an extra free relief option if a player has interference from the ground under repair, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the ground under repair, the player may drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone located near the flower bed to the left of hole 9 putting green.
SCORING	All scoring will be done electronically using the Golfstat Mobile App (golfstat.com).  There will be no paper scorecards used for scoring.
PLAYOFFS & AWARDS	In case of a tie for the Team or Individual Championship, a hole-by-hole playoff will start immediately after the completion of the final round. Players must be ready to play when called. Awards will be presented on the practice putting green following completion of play.
