USGA RULES APPLY EXCEPT AS MODIFIED BY THE WIAA HARD CARD (LOCAL RULES AND TERMS OF COMPETITION) AND BY THE FOLLOWING

| TEES | All play will be from the red tee-markers. |
| METAL SPIKES PROHIBITED | Model Local Rule G-7 [Prohibiting Use of Certain Types of Shoes] is in effect. |
| PACE OF PLAY | Rule 5.6 requires players to play without unreasonable delay. See separate WIAA Pace of Play Policy. Officials may wave up on par 3 holes and provide cart rides if any backups or gaps merit it. |
| ADVICE GIVERS | Each team may name up to two advice givers whom players on the team may ask for advice and from whom players may receive advice during the round. The advice giver must not walk onto a putting green when the ball of a team player lies on it or enter a bunker when the ball of a team player lies in it. Penalty for walking onto a putting green or entering a bunker when not allowed: two penalty strokes, applied to the player's score for that hole. Note 1: Clarification of Rule 24.4b (Advice Giver Must Not Deliberately Stand Behind Player) applies to all advice givers. Note 2: An advice giver is not a member of the Committee. Note 3: An advice giver may start searching for a team member's ball, without causing the player's three-minute search time under Rule 18.2a(1) to begin. |
| GROUND UNDER REPAIR | Defined by white lines. If a player has interference by ground under repair, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in ground under repair, the player may take relief under Rule 16.1. |
| RED PENALTY AREAS AND DROPPING ZONE BEHIND HOLE 1. | Defined by red stakes and/or red lines. The lines prevail. Relief may be taken under Rule 17.1 or Rule 17.2, if applicable. As an extra option if a ball is in the red penalty area behind hole 1 putting green, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the red penalty area behind hole 1 putting green, the player may drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone located behind hole 1 putting green. |
| YELLOW PENALTY AREAS AND DROPPING ZONE FOR HOLE 8 | Defined by yellow stakes and/or yellow lines. The lines prevail. Yellow penalty areas are located on hole 2, hole 5, and hole 8. Relief may be taken under Rule 17.1 or Rule 17.2, if applicable. As an extra option if a ball is in the yellow penalty area on hole 8, including when it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found came to rest in the yellow penalty area on hole 8, the player may drop the original ball or another ball in the dropping zone located behind the creek on hole 8. |
| PRACTISING ON PREVIOUS PUTTING GREEN | Model Local Rule I-2 [Prohibiting Practicing on or Near Previous Putting Green] is in effect. |
| OUT OF BOUNDS | There is no out of bounds at University Ridge. |
| DAMAGED CLUB | Model Local Rule G-9 [Replacement of Broken or Significantly Damaged Club] is in effect. |
| BACK-ON-THE-LINE RELIEF | Model Local Rule E-12 [Ball Played from Outside Relief Area When Taking Back-On-the-Line Relief] is in effect. |
| SPECTATORS | Spectators following the players are required to remain on the paved cart paths and are not allowed to give advice. |
| PLAYOFFS & AWARDS | In case of a tie for the Team or Individual Championship, a playoff will start immediately after the completion of the second round. Players must be ready to play when called. Awards will be presented on the practice putting green following completion of play. |
