
NFHS Wrestling Weekly Rule Interpretations

Our discussion of cut-backs/leg block was modified in this year's NFHS Wrestling Rules Book. It is important that as referees, we understand what is legal and illegal when it pertains to the legs. 
CUT BACK/LEG BLOCK —LEGAL





CUT BACK/LEG BLOCK —IILEGAL

Frame 1: Set-up- Wrestler B picks up single leg—Wrestler A counters with a tight whizzer and slides his free leg behind Wrestler B's nearside leg. Creating an illegal hold, stop and penalize immediately.



Frame 2: Set up as avove.

This ILLEGAL variation, has Wrestler A—jumping to drive his knee into side of Wrestler B's leg creating an ILLEGAL hold, stop and penalize immediately.





Double Knee Kick Back—Illegal
