- \* The cost of the event is \$125.00 per team, which includes Summit materials, t-shirt and lunch. The Summit is scheduled to begin with registration at 8:30 a.m. with the first keynote session to begin at 9 a.m. The event is expected to conclude at approximately 2 p.m.
