

# Summit Registration & Schedule

- Registration is open to all schools; however, because of space availability a limit may be placed on registrations. Please submit your school's reservation by Tuesday, November 20, 2018. See online registration form <http://www.wiaawi.org/Schools/Sportsmanship/2018SportsmanshipSummit.aspx>
- The cost of the event is \$150 per team, which includes Summit materials, t-shirt and lunch. The Summit is scheduled to begin with registration at 8:30 a.m. with the first keynote session to begin at 9 a.m. The event is expected to conclude at approximately 2 p.m.
- Six (6) individuals will comprise a school's team to include students, athletes, coaches, administrators, booster club leaders, cheerleaders, advisors, parents, media, etc. It's your choice of whom you want representing your school.
- Participants will attend two keynote addresses and the choice of five 40-minute break-out sessions during three time slots, which focus on the ideals of sportsmanship/citizenship. The Sportsmanship Summit is designed to promote and cultivate the principles of sportsmanship by encouraging teamwork, sharing resources and providing the impetus to make a difference in local schools. Programming is offered to assist membership schools in addressing their citizenship and sportsmanship issues with students, student-athletes, adult fans, advisors, parents and booster clubs; developing plans to improve or maintain good sportsmanship locally; and assisting schools identify and implement a safe, respectful and education-based environment for high school sports.
