10:30 a.m. – Officials and Coaches Meeting in Multi-Purpose Room

“At this time, judges please report to the Multi-Purpose Room for the Coaches/Judges Meeting.

10:30 a.m. –March-In

“The stretching period has concluded. All gymnasts should report to the South end of the Fieldhouse for today’s march-in. Teams will be announced in alphabetical order.”

10:50 a.m. – First Round Warm-up

"It's time for these gymnasts to show us their talents. Let's get ready to tumble! In Round 1, Medford will be on the Vault, Lakeland is on the Uneven Bars, Ashland will be on the Balance Beam and SPASH is on the Floor Exercise. Coaches please let me know when the bars and vault are set to begin the timed warm-up."

****Wait until coaches have signaled that they are ready for the 10 minute clock to begin.**

"There are 3 minutes left in the warm-up period."

"There are concessions located on the North end of the Fieldhouse. This stand is being sponsored by the SPASH gymnastics Booster Club; please visit their concession stand during tonight's meet."

11:00 a.m. – Round 1 begins

"Round 1 may begin now."

Repeat above script for each round. Give frequent reminders of etiquette.

Conclusion of Meet – Awards Ceremony

"I would like to direct your attention to the center of the floor for our awards ceremony. We will be recognizing the top 5 individuals in each event as well as the runner-up and championship teams. Presenting tonight's awards is SPASH Athletic Director, Stephanie Hauser, assisted by Bonnie Bronk, SPASH Athletic Office Assistant"

1. Present Top 5 places in Vault on medal stand. Pause for photos
2. Present Top 5 places in Uneven Bars on medal stand. Pause for photos
3. Present Top 5 places in Balance Beam on medal stand. Pause for photos
4. Present Top 5 places in Floor Exercise on medal stand. Pause for photos
5. Present Top 5 places in All-Around on medal stand. Pause for photos
6. Announce Team scores, beginning with last place.
7. Announce Runner-Up Team score. Present plaque and medals. Pause for photos
8. Announce Championship Team score. Present plaque and medals. Pause for photos
